Overview of Buddhist sites and monks and lamas in China before the Cultural Revolution. Quite a few of the buildings were later destroyed. Also several photos from Tibet. In 1956 the Buddhist world celebrated the 2500th anniversary of Buddhas parinirvana. This is not mentioned here, but the book was certainly published therefore. Text in English.

Many smiling Tibetans, but also photos of Lhasa still intact, i.a. the entrance chorten. Hugh Richardson published quite an emotional review in the Journal of the Royal Central Asian Society, vol. 52, 1965, pp. 181/182.

Sis and Vanis visited Lhasa in 1954. There is e.g. a detailed photo of the face of the famous Jobo in the Jokhang, which shows a completely different surface structure than the statue today. Also a photo of the famous Avalokiteshvara, which was largely destroyed and only part of the heads are now in exile with the Dalai Lama.

Between 1893 and 1897 Hoernle published the text with an annotated English translation and illustrated facsimile plates, followed by the Sanskrit Index in 1908, and a revised translation of the medical portions (I, II, and III) in 1909. The Introduction appeared in 1912 - all parts are present here, with all illustrations. It was published as Volume XXII of the New Imperial series of the Archeological Survey of India. It is currently assumed that the manuscript was written about 500 - 550 CE, making it the oldest Indian book of its time. The first three texts are on medicine, two are on divination and last two on magical incantations. Completely uncut (the only other copy of this book we handled was slightly cut to adapt the printed text to the size of the colour plates), very large and very heavy book. A French and an English translation of this book have appeared, only the English edition reproduces some of the original illustrations, mostly however in smaller format than in the original. Also numerous portraits and paintings of dignitaries, monks and hierarchs as well as of objects of religious and daily life. Very scarce in the original. Heavy set, additional shipping is likely.
